About UKI Agility

Speedstakes Titling Program

SS Beginners: For dogs that are not eligible for SS Novice, SS Senior and SS Champion levels in the Speed Stakes Program.

SS Novice: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 12 points in the SS Beginners classes. Or a newly registered dog who is eligible for Beginners, but the owner/handler currently runs a Champ level dog in the International Program.

SS Senior: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 20 points in the SS Novice classes.

SS Champion: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 36 points in the SS Senior classes.

International Titling Program

Beginners: For dogs that are not eligible for Novice, Senior and Champion levels in the International Program

Novice: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 12 points, where 8 of those points must be obtained in agility classes. Or a newly registered dog who is eligible for Beginners, but the owner/handler currently runs a Champ level dog in the International Program.

Senior: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 20 points in the Novice classes, where 12 of those points must be obtained in agility classes, 4 from jumping, and 4 from games.

Champion: For dogs that have gained a minimum of 36 points, where 12 of those points must be obtained in agility classes, 12 from jumping, and 12 from games.

Masters Series Tournament Rules

The aim of the Masters is to encourage more competitive running in UKI classes and improve the overall standard of top level agility. The Masters has been created for dogs and competitors whose goal is to compete at both National and International level.

General Rules Open to all UKI Level dogs including Select heights. Separate competition for each height. Agility and Jumping rounds with results combined. Handlers must run in strict running orders, failure to do so will result in elimination. Either Agility or Jumping classes may run first (Amendments to 2nd Edition Rule Book). If a handler has 2 dogs entered within a jump height, they may move their first dog up so that there are as many dogs as possible between their dogs. If this is not possible, they will receive a 6 minute break. If a handler has more than 2 dogs within a jump height and the entry is not large enough for a large enough gap in between all their dogs, the first of their dogs drawn will be allowed to run in between a jump height change, if a jump height change is available before their height. If it is not, the final decision will be made by the judge and show manager, taking into consideration fairness to the competitor and other entrants in the Masters Class. Day of Entries must run first within the running orders of the first class. The second class must run in reverse order of placing from first class. Handlers must run for competition in both rounds to receive a combined score and be eligible for the Final, awards & prizes. The dog must run in the height that he will compete at in the Master's Final. The same dog and handler must run both rounds. Any extraordinary circumstances to be ruled by UKI.

Scoring Standard UK Agility Marking will apply. Faults converted into seconds. 5 faults = 5 seconds. Time faults treated the same as course faults. An elimination = 100 faults plus 60 second course time. An absent or NFC run = 1000 faults with a 60 second course time. Dogs with an absent or NFC run in either the Agility or Jumping will forfeit any Q's or awards gained in the other round; in other words, both rounds must be run for competition. Dogs with double elimination will not be placed. An E in the individual round will not be placed in that round. Dogs with the lowest score will be deemed the winner. In the event of a tie, the Agility result will be the deciding factor.

Final Qualification –2 ways to Qualify: A. Individual Winners of the Masters Agility & Jumping class will qualify for the Final (even if an E is earned in the other round).

B. 1st & 2nd Overall will qualify for the Final (neither round may have an elimination). Only the handler who qualifies the dog through a Master's Heat may run the dog in the Final. If you do not qualify at a local Masters Heat, there will be a last chance heat at the UKI US Open. Final to be held at the USA Open.

Prizes: Of the Prize entry fee; \$5.00 is placed in heat prize fund. Each height has its own prize fund and will be divided as per Masters "Prize Money Guide". Prize fund is for overall winners only. In the event there is not a monetary winner within a height, the prize money will be sent to UKI to be added to the Masters Final. \$1 from each entry fee will be split & placed in the Final prize fund and Team USA WAO fund.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

UK Agility International Rules and Regulations apply to the whole event and all people and dogs must comply with these at all times. As a competitor it is your responsibility to be aware of the rules and regulations as they stand at the time of the show. This show will run under the current edition UK Agility International rules found on the UKI web page.

All dogs and handlers must be registered with UK Agility International in order to compete. UK Agility International's official rules & regulations are available to view free on registration of Handler/Owner to UKI. If you or your dog is not already registered please register online at www.ukagilityinternational.com

Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of **UK Agility International rules and regulations** including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete in UK Agility International Trials, with the exception of dogs over 15 calendar months of age eligible to compete in Nursery Classes & Speedstakes.

Entries without fees paid in full will be returned. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or Guardian if the competitor is a minor.

Refund Policy Entries will not be accepted, changed or altered after the closing date or capping level has been reached except for the purpose of moving to a higher level. A full refund is available for any membership that is not older than 14 days from the creation of the account date. A full refund is available before the closing date or capping level is met for any show. There will be no cost if refund money is to be left in your UKI account. If a refund is requested, then the following administration costs will be incurred. If payment was received by check or money order, then a \$4 administration fee will be incurred. If payment was received by credit card a 4% charge of the refund will be assessed, per transaction. If payment was received from a Pay Pal account, a 4% charge of the refund will be assessed, per transaction. Once a show has been closed and/or capped refunds of any kind for any reason will not be available.

After the closing date, a partial entry may be available for extraordinary circumstances, but this lies with the individual show management based upon their own policies. Contact the show management for details, NOT UKI.

Additional administration charges may be imposed to members' account due to negligence which result in administration time to correct. Possible infractions, but not limited to are: submitting incorrect trial entry information, including incorrect handler and dog number, creating duplicate membership or dog accounts. Charges are based on an hourly rate of \$20 per hour.

A dog shall be withdrawn from competition without refund if it is: suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, interfering with the safety of any person or other animal or if it is likely to cause itself damage or suffering if it continues competing.

There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn and neither in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason for dismissal providing this was within accordance of UK Agility International rules and regulations.

It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Handlers working more than one dog in a class **must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn**. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

It is expressly understood that **Competitors alone are responsible** for the behavior of their dogs, children and guests. Any competitor whose dogs, children, or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may at the discretion of the show management, be asked to remove the offending dogs, children, guests from the event grounds. No refunds of fees will be made in such a case.

No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.

Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge, the show management reserves the right to appoint another judge. Should circumstances so dictate the show manager, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to UK Agility International. In the event of abandonment of the show through circumstances beyond our control, the SHOW MANAGEMENT may defray such expenses from the entry fee to cover the cost of the show preparation. These accounts will then be made public.

All competitors **MUST** clean up after their dogs at all times. Failure to do so will result in competitors being asked to leave the Show. Dogs left in hot cars, or dogs appearing to be in distress, will be dealt with as seen fit by the Show Management.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. **There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks**. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made before a competitor may compete. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls to a UK Agility International account must be paid prior to the start of the event. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice shall be reported to UK Agility International. UK Agility International will suspend a dog's/handlers' registration until fees are paid in full. If your UK Agility International account owes money when we process the entries for this show please be sure you have arranged payment to be made directly to the show. Failure to do this will result in your UKI account being suspended.

All dogs are entered at this show at their owners' risk and whilst every care will be taken the show management and UKI will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.

<u>Media Rights Release:</u> Through the entry into this event, all competitors grant to UKI and its affiliated companies, representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media known now or in the future. Further, I hereby release UKI and its affiliates, representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

Rules of Conduct: UKI promotes dog agility pursuant to regulations consistent with international standards as a competitive, spectator sport. All competitors, officials, and event personnel shall conduct themselves in a professional and sportsmanlike manner consistent with the foregoing statement of purpose and seek to uphold, and enhance where possible, the image of the sport and UKI through such conduct and actions.

Each competitor acknowledges through their entry to the UKI event that their participation is a privilege and not a right. By virtue of their entry, competitors acknowledge and agree to comply with all UKI rules and regulations, and agree to accept any sanctions that may be imposed for failure to comply. The judge has responsibility for determining when it is appropriate to excuse a dog and competitor from the ring based on matters related to competitor misconduct. The UKI show officials have responsibility for determining when an infraction should result in expulsion of a competitor, dog, or any person from the event by conducting the procedure outlined in the UKI rule book. UKI head officials, through further investigation, may impose sanctions including suspension or expulsion from future events.

The following is a partial list of infractions on which the judge or UKI officials may take action: Abuse of a dog on the grounds \Box
Actions that may have the appearance of abuse of a dog \square Willful misconduct or interference with a competitor's right to show \square Any
acts of poor sportsmanship ☐ Violation of procedural rules ☐ Compulsive, correctional training on the grounds ☐ Willful

control of the behavior of their dog. ☐ Intimidation and/or impolite confrontation of judges, event officials, event helpers, or other
competitors ☐ Creating excessive delays as a failure to respect the authority of event officials.

Social Media Conduct rule is in effect. Cyber bullying of any kind towards UKI, competitors, judges, helpers or volunteers will not be tolerated. Examples of cyber bullying include but are not limited to, communications that seek to intimidate, manipulate, falsely discredit, put down, try to control, rudely confront, demand, and comments that try to incite further issues. Further, UKI is committed to maintaining an environment that is built on mutual respect and is free from racism, discrimination and harassment. In keeping with this goal, any behavior that is hateful towards race, color, religion, creed, national origin or ancestry, ethnicity, sex, and gender will not be tolerated. Any of these cases may sanction removal from all associated social media pages and even lead to expulsion of UKI events and even further expulsion of organization membership.

Bitches in season may run at this show. You must notify the show secretary as early as possible to this fact. All BIS must run at the end of the class, after all jump heights have finished in that class and must use a mat on the start line, to be provided by the show. In season pants may be worn while running but handlers allow this at their own risk.

Everyone's safety is our primary concern, especially during the current pandemic. We will comply with Georgia state guidelines for group events. Please keep in mind this is a very fluid situation, and state and local guidelines are subject to change with little notice. We reserve the right to adjust these guidelines as needed. We will try to keep everyone updated of any changes through our Facebook page and emails from the trial secretary. We will be implementing the following guidelines.



- MASKS: Masks must be worn over the nose and mouth when physical distancing of 6' cannot be maintained. Such times where physical distancing is not possible include briefings, walk throughs, gate keeping, scoring, scribing, timing, course building, ring crew (if physical distancing is not possible) and leash running. Competitors are not required to wear a mask when running. Please bring your own mask. We will have backup masks for anyone that has forgotten theirs or has faulty masks. Anyone not complying will be asked to leave the trial without a refund.
- **PHYSICAL DISTANCING:** Practice physical distancing at all times. Chairs will be allowed at ringside with appropriate distancing. In general, please avoid congregating to every extent possible.
- **SANITIZATION:** Wash hands frequently and thoroughly. Use hand sanitizers positioned liberally throughout the arena. We will clean all commonly touched surfaces regularly throughout the trial and again at the end of the day.
- **CRATING:** Crating spaces will be marked off with a minimum of 6 feet spacing. Crating is also recommended out of parked vehicles.
- PARKING: Every other space will be left open. For parking under cover and on the dirt, six feet spacing will be
 required. Be considerate when loading and unloading your car to allow for appropriate physical distancing. If
 crating from your car, please allow for physical distancing.
- **SPECTATORS:** Non-competitors are encouraged to not attend the event but if necessary, they should avoid the competition areas.
- **CHAIRS:** Please bring your own chair and avoid sitting anywhere else.
- **COURSE MAPS/RESULTS:** Course maps and results will be posted to help with physical distancing. Snap pictures to reference maps and results because paper handouts will not be available. Ribbons will be available to pick up off the table. They will be set out individually allowing to be picked up safely.
- **CHECK-IN:** Check in verbally for your run with the gate steward while maintaining a 6 ft. distance. There will be no sign-in sheets. We will be using the Agility Gate app for competitors to check in online.
- **LEASHES:** Leashes will be placed in a bucket for the leash runner to transport to the exit without contact.
- **WALKTHROUGHS:** Based on entries, we will limit the number of people on the course at one time. We encourage everyone to be mindful of others, take turns, and maintain personal distance.
- WARM UP JUMP: Warm up jump will be placed at least 20' away from the ring. Hand sanitizer station will be set in the same area. Please sanitize hands before and after adjusting the bar. Six-foot markings for queuing the use of the jump will be in place.

 RUNNING ORDER: Running order may be adjusted to minimize number of competitors in the ring during walk thrus. A copy of the running order will be posted away from the gate to avoid congregating around the gate area.

WORKERS:

- o Ring Crew: Does not have to wear a mask unless physical distancing is not possible Handler path must be more than 6' or mask must be worn. Please bring your own chair if possible.
- Timers and Scribes: Timers and scribes will be physically distanced. At the end of the class the timer will wipe down the timer box. We recommend using your own pens and will have extras available.
- Gating: Hand sanitizer will be located by the gates. Physical distancing positions will be marked for three dog/handler teams. All others are asked to stay back. Please keep moving out of the exit chute and reward your dog away from the exit area.
- o Course Builders: Physical distancing will be observed. Mask will be required when physical distancing is not possible. Workers are expected to provide their own masks.

Worker bucks will be given to workers to be used for the food vendor, massage vendor or future entries.

Bottled water will be provided to workers.

VENDORS:

- Food: The Sunday Diner will be delivering lunch each day. Competitors may sign up in the morning to order from the menu the Diner has provided. Competitors are responsible for paying for their lunch, worker bucks can be used. Please bring cash if you would like to order lunch. The club will not have a way to take credit or debit cards. Lunch orders will have to be in by 9:15 each morning. The Sunday Diner has agreed to pack each order separate with names to make it easier and safer for us. The Sunday Diner owners and workers are a wonderful bunch and have truly worked hard with us to find a way to provide food during this pandemic time. See below for menu.
- Massage: Sheila Wideman will be providing massage by appointment.
- **REFUNDS:** If at any time before the trial you do not feel comfortable with any of the new requirements, let the trial secretary know and she will shred your check. Please think carefully before entering the trial because no Q, is worth risking your health or the wellbeing of others. Please stay home if you feel ill or if you have been exposed to someone with the virus. We actively encourage you to stay home until you have had no Covid-19 symptoms (fever, cough, etc.) for 14 days or more. If you experience illness, you may contact the trial secretary for a 100% refund.
