Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Trial Instructions and Guidelines

Richmond Dog Obedience Club (RDOC) has put in place the following procedures for our agility trial at Level Up Dogs Sports (LUDS) in Mechanicsville, VA, on March 26th & 27th, 2022, with the safety of our exhibitors and adherence to State and CDC requirements and guidelines being our main priority.

If you do not feel you can comply with any of these requirements please do not enter our trial, we will look forward to seeing you at a future RDOC trial.

Excellent/Master Standard and Excellent/Master JWW classes will run in height order each day as shown in the class diagram. All dogs in Excellent/Master Standard will run their course, then all dogs in Excellent/Master JWW will run their course. Open and Novice classes will be run at the end of the day.

Handlers that have been fully vaccinated against Covid-19 are not required to wear a mask in the building. IF YOU HAVE NOT BEEN FULLY VACCINATED AGAINST COVID-19 YOU MUST WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES. This is Subject to change if the Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia revises the current ordinances. The exact number and size of walkthroughs will be determined after closing.

We will assign walkthrough groups (like NAC or Invitationals) and this will be marked on the running order posted on the trial secretary's website after move-ups have closed. A RDOC member will let each group into the building to walk through the Entry door once the previous group has completed their walk-through and exited using the Exit door.

Food: Snacks & Drinks will be provided to Volunteers. MACH/PACH cakes are welcome!

Please bring with

- Hand sanitizer/Wipes ,
- Mask(s) – **IF YOU HAVE NOT BEEN FULLY VACCINATED AGAINST COVID-19 YOU MUST WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES. inside the building.** A mask must fully cover your nose and mouth, be snug to the sides of the face with no opening; **i.e. no mesh, valves, etc.** If you wear a face shield you must also wear a mask.
- **A leash** that fits in your pocket or around your waist or crossbody during your run. Per AKC guidelines: “exhibitors may choose to place leashes in their pockets or wear them (around waist, crossbody, etc.) during their runs. If the dog grabs the leash this will be scored as "E". If the leash falls out of the handler's pocket, or off of their body, there is no call unless the dog were to grab it.” A leash-runner will be available for exhibitors who do not wish to carry their leash while on course.
- Phone/Ipad with a camera, or a camera, for taking pictures of the results, course maps etc.

LUDS will sanitize equipment and LUDS will disinfect all surfaces, including the floor and equipment, before the event and after each day of the event using EPA-registered disinfectants. LUDS will not provide PPE.

We will have a designated Gate who will mark in exhibitors as they enter the ring for their walk-through– there will be no self check in. There will be an “Entry Only” door into the building (this is on the side where you normally park) you will only exit through the door on the opposite side of the building. There will be fenced off walk ways to the ring and leaving the ring. Only 5 dogs can be inside the building waiting to run. A minimum of 6 feet is to be maintained between each handler while waiting to run. You will be called into the building by the gate. As you enter you may take your coat and treats for your dogs and leave them on a table by the exit door. You must exit immediately after your run and **reward your dog outside the building. Do not stop in the exit walkway.**

Inside crating is restricted and is ONLY for designated key workers/Club members who have been given permission to crate inside by the Trial Chair. Anyone trying to crate inside without permission will be asked to leave. **NOTE: If you volunteer to work one class you may crate inside the building on the day(s) for which you are volunteering.** If crating out of your car, please be aware of the weather – this is Virginia so we could have all 4 seasons in one day! If any of the crating restrictions change we will notify you.

Course Maps will be posted at the trial site each morning, per AKC regulations. Maps may also be available for each class on the Agility Gate App. Additionally the trial secretary will post course maps on Sunrise Agility’s website each day when time permits.

PLEASE NOTE :

The Agility Gate app is an aid only – it is still the responsibility of the handler to make sure they are at their walkthroughs and are at the gate when it is their turn to run – RDOC is not responsible for any delays in communications due to delays with wireless networks.

Ribbons are self-service and will be available on a table inside the building. Please collect your labels and ribbons and exit out of the Exit door. We ask that you maintain social distancing when collecting your ribbons. Results will be posted at the end of each class by the ribbons, they will also be posted on the trial secretary’s website at the conclusion of the day. <https://sunriseagility.com/2021/12/09/march-26-27-richmond-dog-obedience-club/>

We cannot allow general spectators in the building, so sadly there is no viewing/standing to watch the dog running in the Agility ring **except for videoing a run for another exhibitor**. We plan to have runs livestreamed to You Tube courtesy of LUDS. Please subscribe to the Level Up Dogs Sports’ You Tube channel.

Briefings will be held for all classes Please be considerate and exercise social distancing during these briefings.

Measuring dogs – Dogs will be measured if we have a VMO in attendance. The judge of record will NOT measure dogs.

RDOC is partnering with LUDS to make this a safe and fun event. We realize this is different to what we are used to pre COVID. However, the health and safety of everyone is paramount if we wish to run agility at this time. If during the trial you are unable to follow these procedures, we will ask you to leave and your entry fees will not be refunded. We want everyone to be safe.

Walk-throughs and start time for first class will be announced in the trial information after closing.

FEO RUNS (For exhibition only) ARE OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL (FAST ONLY)

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. **The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions.** Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds

All entries, requests for move-up, etc. are promptly responded to. If you do not receive a response within 48 hours, (weekends excluded) please email Tina.

Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address (**max 10 entries per envelope**). No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or email. Entries must be submitted on Official AKC-form with correct entry-fees listed. One dog per form. **Please read the section: "Class changes effective January 1, 2020," posted in the premium, for instructions when entering same dog in multiple heights or mixed regular and preferred classes.**

Agreement on back of form **MUST** be signed. Photo-copies must be legible with original signature. Max 10 entries (dogs) per envelope (includes Express-mail-entries). **NO emailed forms, fax or telephone entries accepted.**

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.** Be sure to include correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 30% online per day, 70% each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

PLEASE NOTE:

Effective 1/2/18, the 26-inch jump height division is replaced by the 24-Choice jump height division.

RINGSIDE - Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY)

For Exhibition Only, (FEO) is offered at this trial (FAST only)

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Rubberized contacts will be used. All classes will take place on synthetic turf. Ring size will be a minimum of 78 x 114 square feet. Clip n Go Rubberized Contacts will be used.

Course WALK-THROUGHS AND Warm-Up INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. No umbrellas allowed on course during walk-throughs.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

AKC RULES AND REGULATIONS

RIBBONS AND AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class.

- ❖ **Qualifying ribbons** will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score
- ❖ **Agility Grand Champion (AGCH)** ribbons will be given to those earning this award at this trial
- ❖ **MACH/PACH** Rosettes and a **MACH/PACH** bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH/PACH title at this trial.
- ❖ **New Title** ribbons will be given to dogs earning a new title.
- ❖ **Double "Q"** ribbons will be given to those exhibitors who double Q in the STD and JWW Master classes on the same day.
- ❖ **"Perfect Score"** ribbons will be given to exhibitors in the Novice, Open and Excellent classes who qualify with a score of 100 points.

All ribbons must be claimed by the end of the Trial; none will be mailed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

MOVE UP REQUESTS

Move ups must be sent in writing (e-mail is acceptable and preferred--NO TEXTS OR INSTANT MESSAGES) to the Trial Secretary for the March 26, 2022 trial, **no later than Monday, March 21, 2022, by 6:00 PM.** Move ups from Saturday to Sunday must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last class on Saturday, The trial secretary will be more than grateful if you will do your move-ups as soon as possible.

BIS, AND INJURY REFUND INFORMATION

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$5 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on Saturday March 26, 2022

Injury/Illness – Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be given a partial refund minus processing fees of \$10.00 per run. A written letter from a certified Veterinarian (on office letterhead) must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on Saturday March 26, 2022. (Letters from chiropractors and massage therapists are not valid). **Injuries/illness to handlers are excluded from this policy**

No Exhibitor Setup prior to Saturday.

Inside crating is restricted and is ONLY for Volunteers/Club members who have been given permission to crate inside by the Trial Chair. Anyone trying to crate inside without permission will be asked to leave.

All turf accidents must be reported immediately and a \$5 clean up fee has to be paid to Level Up Dog Sports. Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
